S + have not (haven't)/has not (hasn't) + past participle
I have not tried sushi.

? Have/Has + subject + past participle?

Have you tried sushi?

EXAMPLES

PRESENT PERFECT SIMPLE TENSE (Presente Perfecto Simple)					
MODO AFIRMATIVO		MODO INTERROGATIVO		MODO NEGATIVO	
I have played	Yo he jugado	Have I played?	¿He Jugado?	I haven't played	Yo no he jugado
You have played	Tú has Jugado	Have you have played?	ظHas إJugado?	You haven't played	<u>Tú no</u> has Jugado
He has played	Él ha jugado	Has he played?	¿Ha Jugado?	He hasn't played	Él no ha jugado
She has played	Ella ha jugado	Has she played?	ظa إJugado?	She hasn't played	Ella no ha jugado
It has played	Él/Ella ha jugado	Has it played?	¿Ha Jugado?	It hasn't played	ÉI/Ella no ha jugado
We have played	Nosotros hemos Jugado	Have we played?	¿Hemos Jugado?	We haven't played	Nosotros no hemos Jugado
You have played	Vosotros habeis Jugado	Have you played?	¿Habeis Jugado?	You haven't played	Vosotros no habeis Jugado
They have played	Ellos han jugado	Have they played?	Hanغ إJugado	They haven't played	Ellos han jugado

USES Usage Example To express things you have done in She has never studied Japanese. your life To express number of times you have How many times have you tried to done something To describe recently completed actions I have some bad news. I've lost my job. which are important now To express situations that started in the I've known James for 4 or 5 years. past and are still true To describe unfinished actions or I've read half of the book. situations To express present result John has missed the bus, so he'll be late.
